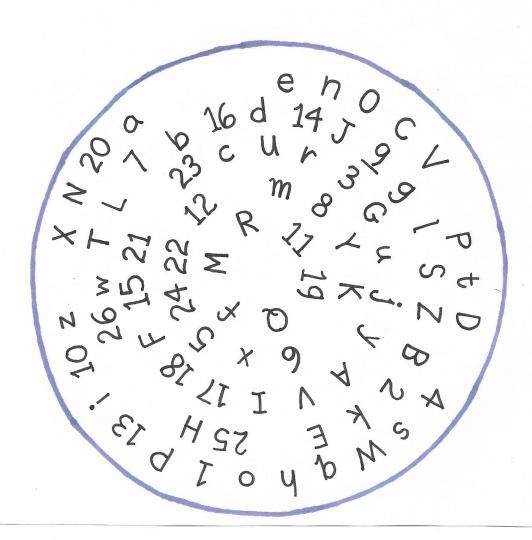

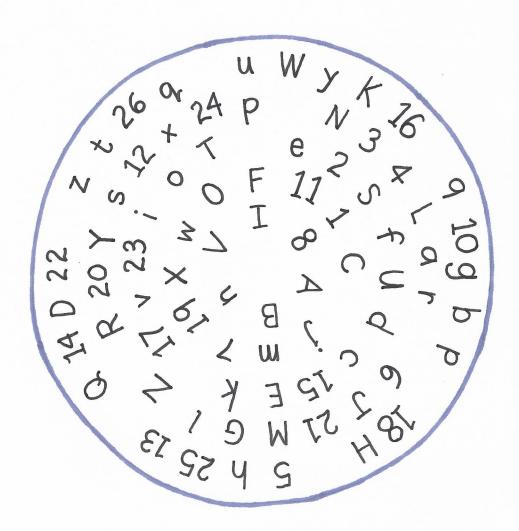
Rotator Tracker: Vision Tool

Option 1: Using a highlighter to mark letters/numbers on the wheel, see how many the client/viewer can find in 1 or 2 minutes. Viewer must mark them off in order; (A,a, 1,B,b,2,C,c,3....) or (Z,z,26,Y,y,25,X,....). They may rotate the wheel as they look.

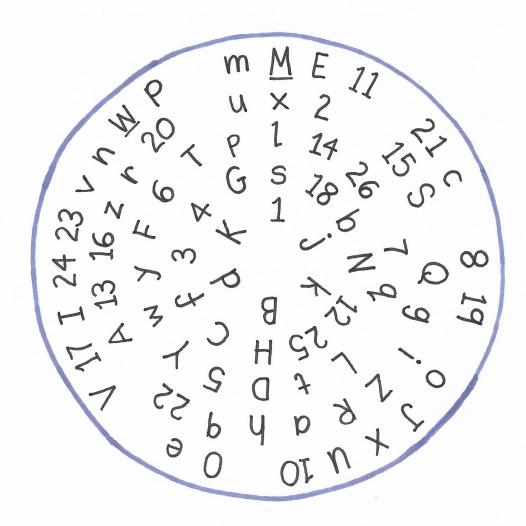
