

# Sensory Bin Ideas

You can fill it with:

Uncooked rice or beans, shredded paper, popcorn, colored boba, play doh, kinetic or sticky sand, beads, water, plastic ans squishy balls, cut up colored straw pieces, spaghetti, water beads, shaving Cream and colored water beads, dyed rice, Styrofoam peanuts, Floam, mini water balloons, play snow (1/2 cup shampoo and 2 cups Baking Soda), slime, sugar,plastic animals, lego pieces, dyed pasta, and gift wrapping paper shreds.

You can hide:

Cars, sensory words, sight words, articulation words, question cards, office supplies (paper clip, marker, pencils, erasers,..) Crayons, plastic letters or small toys, easter eggs, dyed macaroni, shoe laces, coins, dice, small blocks, and small fuzzy toys.

You can pick items out with:

Fingers, tongs, spoons, sand shovels, measuring cups, magnets, and toothpicks.
