



OT Classroom Basics

Check to see if your students can do the following:

- Turn paper over and fold it.**
- Know the meaning of an arrow con.**
- Look where someone points.**
- Visual orientation starts from the top and works bottom.**
- Have right to left orientation when doing classwork.**
- Turn puzzles or paper around so that they are upright.**
- Follow a list or schedule.**
- Locate/copy items such as assignment list on dry erase board.**
- Locate or identify a paragraph in a book/newspaper (Grade 5 and above)**
- Be able to use abbreviations and understand benefit. (Grade 5 and above)**
- Open and close their locker, backpack, and lunch box.**
- Use a ruler, scissors, and other classroom tools.**
- They are able to locate the restroom and front office if needed.**
- Able to use a wallet or purse to produce student ID and personal information. (especially in high school)**
