

## Walking Tests for School PT's

- TUG- This measures the time it takes to move from seated to standing position and walk 3 meters turn around again and sit back into the same seat.
- TFTS- This measures the time it takes to get up from the floor, walk 3 meters, and then return back to the same spot and sit down.
- Dynamic Gait Index- Evaluates walking ability while performing different tasks or gait demands
- 30-second Walk Test (30sWT)- This measures the amount of distance walked in 30 seconds.
- 50-foot Walk Test (50fWT)- This provides 2 measures; amount of time it takes to walk 50 feet and the maximum amount of time it takes to walk 50 feet that is acceptable to teachers/staff.
- Energy Expenditure Index (EEI)- This measures the energy cost of efficiency of walking at a comfortable speed or quickly for 2-3 minutes.
- 6-Minute Walk Test- This endurance test measures how far a student walks in 6 minutes.
- Perceived Exertion Scales- These pictorial scales help seek the child's perception of how much effort is used to complete a task.
- Functional Mobility Scale (FMS)- This test qualifies the use of assistive devices for 3 distances; home(50m), school(50m), and community (500m).
- Timed Up & Down Stairs (TUDS)- This measures the time it takes to get up 1 flight of stairs, turn around and then descend that same flight of stairs.
