Pine Cone Painting

Simple. Easy. Sensory. Social. All ages. Bilateral UE. Balance. Seated or Standing Level. Fine Motor. Ornamental.

Supplies:

- 1. Pine cones
- 2. White paint (You can use other colors)
- 3. 2-3 Plates, etc. (for putting paint or glitter in)
- 4. OPTION: place glitter on painted cone and use ribbon or pipe cleaner (made into a hook) to hang it on a tree or wall.

Directions:

- 1. Take a pinecone and roll it in white paint or shake the pinecone in a container with paint in it.
- 2. Roll painted pinecone into glitter (you may choose to shake container to get cone painted.)
- 3. Lay painted pinecone on butcher paper or plate to dry.
- 4. Use ribbon or pipe cleaner on cone to hang it.
